



Rate Changes – Microsoft Products – July 1, 2026

Notification Date: June 1, 2026

Microsoft will implement pricing changes for select services and licensing models beginning July 1, 2026. As a result, pricing for certain Microsoft-related services provided through TPx may also change.

These updates are tied to Microsoft’s pricing adjustments and may vary depending on subscription type, licensing model, term commitment, and billing structure. Customers may see updated pricing at their next renewal, term change, or license modification occurring on or after July 1, 2026.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why are these prices changing?

Microsoft periodically adjusts pricing for certain products, subscription models, and licensing programs. These changes are being passed through to applicable TPx-managed Microsoft services.



When will the changes take effect?

Microsoft's updated pricing takes effect July 1, 2026. Depending on your agreement and subscription structure, updated pricing may apply at your next renewal, license change, or term adjustment occurring on or after that date.

Will all Microsoft services be impacted?

No. Only select Microsoft services, subscription types, and licensing models are affected.

Will my pricing change immediately on July 1?

Not necessarily. Many customers will not see updated pricing until their next renewal event or license modification after July 1, 2026.
